# Salvation past, present & future (1 Cor 15:1-2)

### II Essential convictions about the future

Article 10: Response and Eternal Destiny

"We believe that God commands everyone everywhere to believe the gospel by turning to Him in repentance and receiving the Lord Jesus Christ. We believe that God will raise the dead bodily and judge the world, assigning the unbeliever to condemnation and eternal conscious punishment and the believer to eternal blessedness and joy with the Lord in the new heaven and the new earth, to the praise of His glorious grace. Amen."

- 1 Future visible & bodily return of Jesus Christ
- 2 Future (bodily) Resurrection
- 3 Future **Judgment**
- 4 Eternal condition & destination: life in the new heavens & new earth

OR death in the lake of fire

### I) Jesus Christ will return

- Promised and expected
  - o Foretold & promised by Jesus himself (Mt 24:30-31; 25:31)
  - o Promised by angels (Acts 1:11)
  - o NT writers affirmed his coming return (1 Thess 4:15-17; 1 Peter 1:7, 13; 4:13; 5:4; James 5:7-8; 1 John 2:18; 3:2)
- What is the purpose of his return? To bring salvation!!! (Heb 9:28)
- Timing of the return of Christ:
  - o Only God knows the precise time and day (Mt 24:36, 42)
  - o General signs and forerunners (Mt 24; Mk 13; Lk 21)
    - Preaching of the gospel to every nation (Mt 24:14, 33-34)
    - Rebellion & man of lawlessness is revealed (2 Thess 2:3)
- How then shall we live (impact on Christians)?
  - 1) Constant expectancy (vigilance)

Mt 24:42, 44; Lk 12:40; 1 Thess 5:4, 6; Rom 13:11-14; 2 Peter 3:10-12; Rev 3:3

- 2) Blessed Hope
  - o See & be with Christ (Titus 2:13; Php 3:20; 1 John 3:2)
  - o Coming righteousness (Gal 5:5)
  - o Coming day of redemption (Eph 4:30)
  - o Sanctification completed (Php 1:6, 20; 2:16; 1 Thess 5:23-24)
  - o Glory & joy (Col 3:4; 1 Thess 2:19; 2 Thess 1:9-10)
  - o Blameless in holiness (1 Thess 3:13; 5:23-24
  - o Patient, eager waiting (Rom 8:22-24; 1 Cor 1:7; James 5:8; 1 Cor 16:22)
- 3) Motivation to God-glorifying living
  - o Strive to be servants who actively love others (Mt 24:45-51)
  - o Strive to be good and faithful servants (Mt 25:14-30)

#### II) Future (bodily) Resurrection

- How: Dead come to life (Daniel 12:2; John 5:28-29)
- Who: Every human being, both just & unjust (Acts 24:15)
- What is the nature of the resurrected body:
  - o Physical (2 Cor 5:1-10; Job 19:25-27)
  - o Glorified (Php 3:20-21)
  - o Eternal, powerful, spiritual, heavenly-image-bearer (1 Cor 15:35-50)

#### III) Future Judgment

- Fore-planned: Fixed 1) Court date, 2) Judge appointed, 3) Standard (Acts 17:30-31)
- Separates the sheep from the goats (Mt 25:31-46)
- Each person judged according to one's works (2 Cor 5:10; Rev 20:12-13; Mt 16:27)
- Varied sentencing (Mt 10:15; 11:22-24) and reward (2 Cor 5:10; 1 Cor 3:10-15)
- The judgment of God separates all people towards either of two destinations... Mt 7:13-14; 25:32, 46; Rev 20:15; 21:27

#### IV) Eternal condition & destination

- 1. Eternal Punishment in the Lake of Fire
  - Where? Hell (Mt 23:33)
  - Alienation: apart from God in 'outer darkness'
    (Mt 8:12; 13:42, 50; 22:13; 25:30; 2 Pet 2:17; Jude 13; 2 Thess 1:9)
  - Wrath, condemnation, & death:
    - o Eternal & conscious (Mt 25:41, 46)
    - Eternal fire, weeping & gnashing of teeth
      (Mk 9:43, 48; Mt 18:8; Jude 7; Rev 14:9-11; 21:8)
    - o Eternal Corruption (Rev 21:8)
- 2. Eternal Life in the New Heavens & New Earth
  - Where? New Heavens & New Earth (Rev 21:1-5; 2 Pet 3:13; Rom 8:21-23)
  - Reconciliation: dwell with God in 'light' (Rev 21:3; Mt 13:43; Rev 21:23; 22:5)
  - Peace, joyful delight, blessedness & eternal life (Rev 19:7; Mt 22:2; 25:1-13; Rev 22:1-5)
